On our website you will find a chart with the forms that need to be completed by each club during the Federation year to remain in good standing along with their due dates. Each form on the chart must be postmarked by the date indicated. The chart also shows the Federation officer to whom the form must be sent and the local club officer who should complete it. Please contact the appropriate Federation officer with any questions. Contact information for each officer is on the form and located on our website – <https://aggiemoms.org/officers/>.

These forms help us manage records for the local clubs, track scholarship and student organization donations, and allow us to remain compliant with our 501(c)3 tax designation. They also provide a way for you to register for various Federation events like Boutique or nominate a club member to serve as a Federation officer.

The forms for this year have not been finalized yet, but will be final before January 1, 2019 and will be available for download on the Federation website prior to the January 2019 Federation Meeting at <https://aggiemoms.org/forms/>. We will discuss the forms at the January 2018 meeting, so it is important that you attend the meeting so you can understand the purpose, the deadlines, and to whom the form is returned.
