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Remaining Relevant



- Make phone calls to ask for volunteers
- Poll your members for ideas- make them feel like they have a say in club activities and decisions

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Remaining Relevant



- Frequent and regular communication with your members
 - Use multiple forms for communication
 - Newsletters (these can be emailed)

Remaining Relevant



- Keep your mission present in your meetings
 - Invite your scholarship recipients and their families to a special meeting/dinner
 - Honor your graduates and their moms (give each mom & dad a Payday candy bar, give the graduate a special keepsake, etc.)
 - Read some of the thank you letters from students (scholarship recipients and/or those part of a campus student organization your club has helped) at your meetings

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Remaining Relevant



- Create a large event to coincide with CAMPUS events (Family Weekends, etc.)
- Participate in your clubs local Muster Ceremony (upcoming: April 21, 2020)
- $\bullet\,$ Have a Dad's Appreciation dinner with a speaker that is of interest to them
- Make your goody bag assembly and delivery a club wide event
- Smaller clubs use larger clubs as mentors (for programs, activities, etc.)

	Invite	Ask them to call and invite the new moms to sit with them at meetings
	Stay in Contact	Stay in contact and introduce the new moms to others with similar interests
	Make Calls	Make calls or send notes if a new mom doesn't come to a couple of meetings
