### **A HOWDY FROM THE PRESIDENT ELECT!**



Howdy Moms! YOU DID IT! GREAT JOB on getting your Form 990 submitted on time. I am so proud of you ALL!!

Next up is Form T – Due February 1, 2021. Please submit early if you can and check this OFF your TO Do List!

Each year we are required to update our records with the IRS concerning our subordinate clubs. To comply with this IRS requirement, we ask you to work with your Treasurer to provide your club's information. All 109 Aggie Mom clubs have an exemption from Federal income tax through the Federation's determination as a 501(c)(3) organization. As the parent tax-exempt organization, the Federation is required to furnish the IRS with a complete listing of subordinate groups – our local clubs – each year. We do this by collecting current information on all our clubs through the Form T. The Form T is for Federation internal record keeping only. Form T is not filed with the IRS. Please note returning the Form T to the Federation does not exempt your club from filing a Form 990 each year with the IRS. The current Form T and a cover letter regarding the Form T is located on the Federation website at <https://aggie moms.org/wp-content/uploads/2020/09/Form-T.pdf>

To ensure that your club remains covered under the Federation exemption, please provide ALL information requested on Form T. The Federation's group exemption filing is due to the IRS by the end of February every year. So that we may complete our required filing in a timely manner, please complete your Form T and remit it to Katie Latham, 15332 CR 1227 Flint, TX 75762 no later than February 1, 2021. Form T information may also be scanned and emailed to Katie Latham at [preselect@aggienetwork.com](mailto:preselect@aggienetwork.com). Failure to return a Form T could result in your club's removal from the Federation group exemption. You may access Form T directly at:

As we head into the spring semester of the 2020-2021 school year, I just want to remind the club presidents, treasurers and scholarship chairs that the following forms **are due to the 4th VP-Reports on May 31, 2021:**

Form D - Aggie Moms' Club Annual Report

Form E - Donations to TAMU Student Organizations

Form G - Scholarships Awarded by Member Clubs

These forms provide important information for the 2020-2021 fiscal year (6-1-20 thru 5-31-21) about your club's annual activities and events, donations to TAMU Student Organizations and scholarships that your clubs award. We use these forms to help us manage records for the local clubs, track scholarship and student organization donations and allows us to remain compliant with our 501(c)3 tax designation.

The forms are available on the Federation website (<https://aggiemoms.org/forms/>). Be sure to fill out all of the information required on Form D plus the "RECAP" Section. This section is very beneficial to share new ideas on fundraisers, speakers for club meetings, and scholarships with other clubs. Also, even if your club **does not** make donations or award scholarships, Forms E and G stating this must be submitted.

Planning on attending the Federation Winter Meeting and Workshops in January, please join us for our Scholarship Workshop to learn more about these forms and how to set-up and manage scholarships through TAMU.

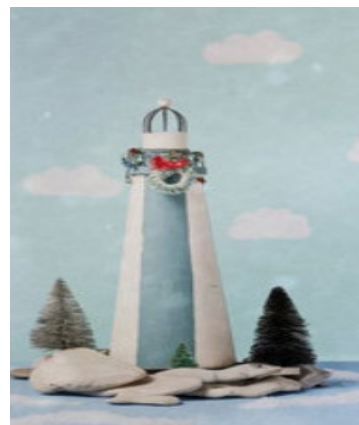

Due to the rising positivity numbers/rates in Brazos County and other concerns with regards to COVID, the decision has been made to CANCEL Aggie Mom Camp 2021. We regret to have to make this decision but the health, safety and well-being of our campers, counselors, staff and vendors is what is important during this unprecedented time of COVID.

If you registered for AMC 2021, all fees will be refunded. Please allow us time to process all the refunds due to the large number of transactions.

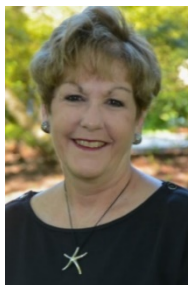

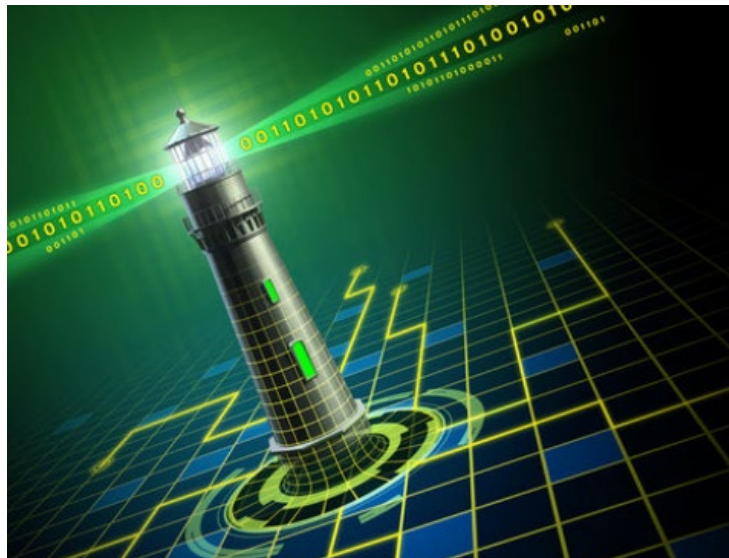

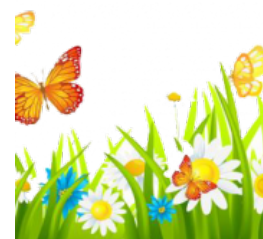
