Also due May 31st are Form E, which reports your Club's Donations to TAMU Student Organizations, and Form G, which reports your Club's Scholarship Awards. Even if your Club did not make any donations or award any scholarships, please submit Forms E and G so we have one for every Club. You will find Forms D, E and G, their instructions, and all Federation forms on the Federation website at https://aggiemoms.org/forms/. Please be sure to read the instructions for each form prior to completing and submitting.

I would like to give a big Aggie Mom Brag to our Clubs for having a combined overall submission rate of 78% for the 2019-2020 Forms D, E and G, but, especially, for the 81% submission rate for both Forms E and G. WHOOP !! Let's see if we can top those numbers for 2020-2021 form submissions.
