

Howdy Aggie Moms! I am so excited to share the final 2020-2021 numbers, representing the impact of all of the hard work for all of the Aggie Moms' Clubs:

> Donations to on campus organizations: **\$110,795.82** Scholarship funds raised: **\$563,546.60** Grand total: **\$674,342.42**

In the Fall, I announced that we had started the process of going digital for our Federation Forms. With the next round of form submissions, due on February 1<sup>st</sup>, we will have completed the process!

Form B (for dues and archive fees) and Form T (for IRS Compliance) are required for all Clubs, while Form A (Federation Board Nominations) and Form F (Boutique reservations) are only submitted as applicable. All Forms will be accessible from our <u>website</u> in December.

We are working on an option to be able to pay dues and archive fees online with a Club card, not a personal one. All Club Presidents will be notified when this is in place.



## DESIGNATING A FEDERATION DELEGATE

Did you know, all clubs have voting delegates? Delegates represent your club and have a voice in the Federation. The Federation bylaws specify a minimum number of delegates representing clubs are necessary to hold our Fall, Winter, and Spring Federation meetings. Volunteering to be a club delegate is a fantastic introduction to all the Federation does to provide support and resources to you, our 110 member clubs.

### Here's how to submit your delegates:

- 1. Submit your delegates and alternates via the link provided by the 3rd VP of Registration. Watch for the link in your email late December.
- 2. Notify the 3rd VP of Registration by email at <u>3rdvpregistration@aggienetwork.com</u> if an alternate will be substituting for a delegate.
- 3. Ensure your designated delegates/alternates attend either via Zoom or in person.

### What are my Responsibilities as a Delegate?

- 1. Participating as a delegate has never been easier, because you may participate in person or on-line.
- 2. Either stop by the delegate table or sign in on Zoom to check in as a delegate.
- 3. If you are a delegate attending in person, please sit in the reserved section.
- 4. If you are a delegate on zoom, a moderator will be monitoring the chat during the meeting.
- 5. Vote on motions presented during the business meeting.

### How do I vote?

When a vote takes place, these are one of the three ways it will happen: 1. Unanimous Consent, 2. Yes/No Vote, or 3. Ballot.

### 1. Unanimous Consent

### What does it mean?

Unanimous consent means asking if anyone agrees with the motion. A motion may be passed without a formal vote being taken helping the meeting run smoothly and effectively. Unanimous consent is often used for minutes, or adjournment, or items that everyone seems to agree with.

### What it looks like:


The President will say "If there are no objections, (pause), the \_\_\_\_\_\_ is/are approved.

During the pause, if you disagree with the motion, you have the right to interrupt with "I object". Wait until recognition from the President, state your name and club and the reason for your objection.

If you are an online delegate, you may use the raised hands emoji to alert the moderator you have an objection to the motion. The moderator will signal the President, wait until you are recognized, state your name, club, and your reason for the objection.

If anyone disagrees with the motion, one of the other voting types will be used.

### 2. Yes/No Votes

### What does it mean?

Yes/No Votes means asking an opinion if a motion should be approved. Federation meetings use yes/ no votes to pass bylaws and other motions which may require discussion.

### What it looks like:

In Person delegates will be given a voting card. When instructed, you will raise your card to vote either "yes" or "no", while the cards are being counted. Please keep the card raised until you are asked to lower your card.

Online delegates will vote using the online poll feature. The President will give you any additional instructions before the Electronic Media Chair posts the poll.

#### 3. Ballot Voting

#### What Does it mean?

A ballot vote is used for elections or anytime a particularly sensitive or divisive issue where pressure might prevent people from voting how they really feel about a motion.

#### What it looks like:

In person delegates will receive a printed ballot and will receive any additional instructions from the President.

Online delegates will vote using the online poll feature. Online delegates will vote using the online poll feature. The President will give you any additional instructions before the Electronic Media Chair posts the poll.
