

### Aggie Moms' Library Endowment (04-57152)

- Established in 1991 by the Federation of Texas A&M University Mothers' Clubs
- The original goal for the endowment was \$500,000
- The purpose of the endowment is to support undergraduate study
- Is not used for the maintenance of your papers archived in the Cushing Library.
- Endowment was completed in 2021! Thank you!!



### **Supports Undergraduate Study**

The income earned from the endowment is used for equipment, services, furniture, textbooks, and outreach. Examples:

- \$10,000 is set aside each year to purchase textbooks which are available for check out (hourly basis) in the Evans Annex
- Renovations to the popular Media Studio
- Upcoming plans for using the income from the endowment include the renovation and furnishings for a flexible and interactive area on the sixth floor of Evans Annex



#### Things to Know:


- Each year the Federation writes 2 separate checks
- Same account number of both checks, however, the check notes field is the most important part of this check. Each check should differentiate between Federation and Aggie Moms Cushing fees.
- Both checks will be almost identical with 2 exceptions:
  - The check for the Federations' papers will always be \$1,000 (flat fee)
  - The check for the Aggie Moms' papers will be a different dollar amount depending on the size of clubs or if a new club is created.




## Aggie Moms' Clubs Archival Maintenance Fee – Check #2

- For the purpose of archiving the materials from the individual clubs
- Amount is based on \$0.25 per member in club
- Comes from every club when they pay their dues and fees to the Federation in February
- Also includes any start-up fees paid by newly chartered clubs (\$30 per new club per 100 members)
- Make check payable to Texas A&M Foundation
- On the memo line, include: "#05-57429 Aggie Moms Cushing Archives Fee"


