

COUNTY OF DALLAS) KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, Mrs. George T. Brundrett,
Mrs. W. S. Mosher and Mrs. H. L. Peoples, all citizens
of Dallas, Dallas County, State of Texas, under and by
virtue of the laws of this state, do hereby voluntarily
associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming
a private corporation under the terms and conditions here-
inafter set out as follows:

(1)

The name of this corporation is DALLAS
A and M COLLEGE MOTHERS CLUB.

(2)

The purpose for which it is formed is for
educational purposes; to-wit: encouraging students at
the Agricultural and Mechanical College of Texas in their
college work; expressing solicitude in the mental, moral
and physical welfare of the said students; stimulating
interest among others for said college and engaging in
any other activities that are calculated to and will pro-
mote the welfare, progress and development of said educa-
tional institution and the young men who attend the same.
This corporation shall have any other right and authority
that may be exercised in connection with said business and
as indicated by Section 2 of Article 1302, Chapter 1,
Title 32 of the Revised Statutes of the State of Texas of
1925.

(3)

The place where the business of this corpora-
tion shall be transacted is the State of Texas, with its
principal office at Dallas, Dallas County, Texas.

(4)

The estimated value of the assets of this corporation is approximately \$180.00 and prior to the presentation of this charter for filing this organization has been in existence from and after February, 1922 and by more than a majority vote of its membership voted to incorporate the Association.

(5)

This corporation shall exist for a term of fifty years.

(6)

The business of this corporation shall be transacted by a board of directors, fourteen in number, who shall be elected by the members of this corporation annually at its regular meeting as determined and fixed by the by-laws of the corporation. The following named members are hereby declared to be directors for the first year and until their successors are elected, to-wit:

The officers of this corporation shall be such officers as provided for by and in its by-laws. All officers shall be elected at the annual meeting of the corporation or at such times as provided for in the by-laws of this corporation and such officers shall hold office until their successors are duly elected and qualified.

This corporation shall have regular and special meetings of its members and its officers at such times and places provided for by the by-laws of the corporation.
